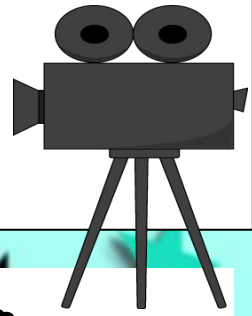


Now Showing in 5th Grade class
