What's going on

CKLA:

This week we reviewed how women broke barriers during the Renaissance. We also read about how the Italian Renaissance inspired people in Northern Europe. They began working on their paragraphs for their biographies as well.

Math:

We started our last unit of math. We are going to be classifying shapes and working on area and perimeter. This week was all about classifying triangles and quadrilaterals.
