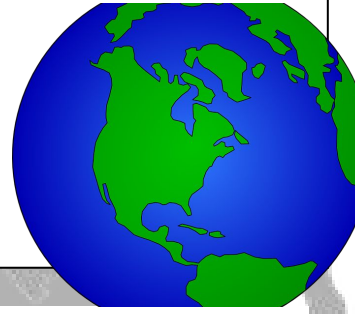


New Adventures in 5th Grade
